### ***Strengthening the capacity of the Public Ministry to deliver better results in fighting petty corruption***

In the period 2013 – 2014, Superior Council of Magistracy (SCM), National Institute of Magistracy (NIM) and Public Ministry (PM) are implementing the Project “*Strengthening the capacity of the Public Ministry to deliver better results in fighting petty corruption*”, co-financed by Switzerland through The Swiss-Romanian Cooperation Programme to Reduce Economic and Social Disparities within the Enlarged European Union.

The Swiss Contribution is of 90,165 CHF (85%) and the Romanian co-financing to be provided by SCM is of 15,911 CHF (15%); the budget of the project being 106,076 CHF.

Within the project, joint training activities will be organized, by the project’s experts and with involvement of the NIM trainers. The target groups consist of Romanian prosecutors with competences in the field of investigation and prosecution of corruption cases, with focus on special investigation techniques for petty corruption.

Thus, the overall objective will be to improve the Romanian prosecutors’ skills to fight petty corruption, by ensuring an intensive training and best practices exchange with their counterparts in Europe.

The activities of the project should be synthesized as follow:

- Romanian prosecutors will be trained on investigation and prosecution of petty corruption cases throughout the organization of 5 workshops (4 days each workshop) for Romanian prosecutors with competences in the field of investigation and prosecution of corruption cases, with focus on special investigation techniques for petty corruption. In order to allow territorial representation at training activities, the locations foreseen for the development of workshops are: Bucharest, Timișoara, Iași, Cluj and Brașov;
- Training materials shall be elaborated to the NIM and PM and will be published on the websites of NIM and PM for all Romanian prosecutors.
