

## STUDY VISITS AT THE EUROPEAN COURT OF HUMAN RIGHTS

---

- **Length**  
One week (4 or 5 working days)
- **Place:** Strasbourg, France
- **Aim:** Provide a deeper knowledge of ECHR
- **Public**  
Judges and prosecutors (including trainees)
- **Number of places available**  
Around 40 places in 2 groups (English and French speaking)
- **Dates**
  - 27 September – 1<sup>st</sup> October 2010 for the English speaking group (applicants to this specific study visit are therefore required to have a good level of English)
  - 6 – 10 December 2010 for the French Speaking group (applicants to this specific study visit are therefore required to have a good level of French)
- **Indicative content** (a detailed agenda will be sent to selected participants)
  - General presentations on the Convention
  - General presentations on the functioning of the Court and the Registry
  - Sessions on specific questions (articles, current issues...)
  - Attendance to an hearing (for the English group, case *Giulani and Gaggio vs Italy*, N°23458/02; for the French group, case *Palomo Sanchez and others vs Spain*, N°28389/06, 28955/06, 28957/06, 28959/06, 28961/06, et 28964/06)
- **Languages requirements**  
Participants must have good command of either English (for the first group) or French (second group).  
Please be aware that the study visit can take place in only one language. EJTN therefore kindly asks you to apply only for the study visit organized in a language you master.
- **Financial conditions**  
Daily allowance of 183,75 euros will be paid to the participants for the days of the study visits as well as the day before and the day after if relevant.
